# Statewide Issues:

- How do buildings implement a RTI framework to achieve intended benefits for ALL students?
- How do buildings scale-up effective practices so they are available to ALL students?
- How does OSPI align systems, structures, and functions to fully support scale-up efforts to create a new “education as usual” philosophy?

# Outcomes

- Model professional development best practices
- Shared vision and common voice
- Scaling-up with ESDs
- Increasing capacity and sustainability

# Scaling-up Opportunities

- Regional partners are using with their districts
  - ESD 101; ESD 189; School Psych Conference
- District administrators received facilitators training
- Lead to modification of building level implementation tool
- Regional trainings by state staff

# Evaluation

92% of the participants found the *Time for Team Planning* to contribute to a successful Summit experience

- “This was one of the greatest assets of the process”
- “We needed that time to process what we had learned at the conference to inform our plan”
- “The time to discuss and consider applications to our school was valuable, otherwise we would all go back to our school with little or no impact”

# Evaluation continued

93% of the participants found the *Opportunity to attend RTI Presentations in combinations with the team planning sessions* contributed to a successful Summit experience

- “Allowed our team to take the information and make it actionable”
- “The biggest problem was that most of the RTI sessions were full”

# Evaluation continued

94% of the participants said they would  
*Attend another RTI Summit for Team  
Planning*
